Dear Parents

I hope you are all safe and well. We are now busy preparing our rooms, resources and curriculum for a full return in September. We are all keen to hit the ground running both safely and in line with government guidance.

Unless we return to some kind of lockdown we will welcome you all back in September. Following guidance issued on Thursday 2nd we are formulating a staggered start, break time and finish structure and we will share this with you as soon as we can.
