We will be studying Georgia O'Keeffe's Poppies painting. We will be looking at drawing our own poppies from observation, using different media.

D&T

We will be designing and making a WW2 utility belt using different stitches.

Properties and Changes of Materials

We will look at the different properties of materials to compare and group materials.

We will be practising our fieldwork and map reading skills to build our knowledge of our local area and the United Kingdom.

We will learn World War Two, the Blitz and the Battle of Britain, finding out what the impact the war had on people in our locality and what life was like for children during the war.

Sacred Writings: Hinduism

Explore a variety of forms of literature found in sacred books and investigate a range of religious teachings.

Explore the symbolic use of a wide range of objects, sounds, visual images, actions and gestures and make suggestions as to the intended meaning they might have for believers.

We will learn about what different families and friendships might look like; what safe relationships look like and how we can respect ourselves and others.
